Since implementing the E-filing system, it appears that attorneys seeking Orders of Protection have been filing an individual order for each case in which they appear. In the interest of efficiency and judicial economy, and to prevent unnecessary work by the Clerk of Court personnel, it is


**ORDERED** that any attorney at law requesting an Order of Protection shall submit to the Clerk of Court a single order listing each and every case in which they appear. The request shall contain the reason for protection. It is further

**ORDERED** that any attorney at law requesting an Order of Protection shall provide a copy of such e-filed order to all counsel of record and any pro se parties appearing in any cases that the attorney has pending before the Court. It is further

**ORDERED** that this Administrative Order shall go into effect January 1, 2019, and shall thereafter remain in effect unless rescinded by the Chief Justice of the State of South Carolina or the Chief Administrative Judge of the Court of Common Pleas of the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit.
