NON-CUSTODIAL PARENTS

Support Payments may be made through one of following methods below.

- 1). Mail payments to Columbia - **(NO PERSONAL CHECKS)** Money Orders, Cashier Checks Only
 - 2). Wage Withholding
 - 3). On-line through the Kidstar Program *(Ask clerk's office for details)*
 - 4). Phone Payment
 - 5). Walmart Stores or CVS Pharmacies
- * You will receive a toll-free number & a member ID number from the state to call when you have questions about your support account(s).
 - * *GovNetPay* on-line service will be disabled April 15. The state DSS office will notify you when the on-line service is restored. Meanwhile, mail in your payments or make payments at the local clerk's office until June 2.

CUSTODIAL PARENTS

- 1). Checks will be mailed from Columbia
 - 2). If you are not using direct deposit, the state will issue you a debit card.
 - 3). Columbia will handle all payment concerns.
 - 4). The Clerk of Court's office will handle enforcement concerns.
- * The state DSS office will provide you a member ID number and a toll-free number to call when you have questions about your support account(s). Answers to routine questions such as last payment date, amount paid, issuance of bench warrant, hearing date, etc.
