
Re: NOTICE OF REPRESENTATION IN ALL CRIMINAL CASES

Pursuant to the authority granted to me as Administrative Judge of the Court of General  
Sessions of the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, it is

**ORDERED** in conjunction with the South Carolina Court Administration and the Clerks  
of Court's offices, that from this date forward, all attorneys practicing in the Circuit Court with  
criminal cases, must immediately file a Notice of Representation regarding your participation in  
any criminal case. If you fail to file the Notice of Representation you will not receive  
notifications regarding the Criminal Court docket system. This notice is in addition to your  
responsibility to notify the Solicitors Office. You must also file a Notice of Representation with  
the proper Clerk of Court's office regarding your particular case. It is further

**ORDERED** that this Administrative Order shall go into effect immediately, and covers  
all pending and future cases. It is further

**ORDERED** that this directive shall remain in effect unless rescinded by the Chief Justice  
of the State of South Carolina or the Chief Administrative Judge of the Court of General  
Sessions of the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit.
