Council votes to offer County Administrator job to Angela Christian

GEORGETOWN COUNTY — Georgetown County Council voted unanimously following an executive session on March 10 to offer the job of County Administrator to Angela Christian, former town manager for the Town of Newport, N.C. If she accepts the job, she will take over as the county's top executive on a date to be announced, relieving interim administrator Wesley Bryant, who is providing administrative services under a contract with Waccamaw Regional Council of Governments. Longtime County Administrator Sel Hemingway, who held the position since 2008, retired on Feb. 29.

Christian was city manager for the Town of Newport from 2014 until 2019. The town has a population of 4,800. Prior to that, she was Chief Operations Officer and deputy county manager for Onslow County, N.C. It has a population of 180,000. She also worked as finance director for Columbus, Ga., and was Deputy City Manager for the City of Bristol, Tenn.

Christian has a Master of Public Administration from the University of Tennessee, and a bachelor's degree in political science from Georgia Southern University.
