Question 1: I have just been asked to bid on the pavement markings for Bid 16-035. We do have a concern about the existing markings on Wildcat Way. After the seal coat is applied, the new SCDOT Spec Layout will not match the existing lines. After a few years of the seal coat life, it will wear off and the existing markings will begin to show again. My question is, Does Georgetown County want the existing lines removed before Seal Coating the road? Thank you for your time.

Response: **The County will request an “Add/Alternate” item for removal of the existing lines prior to the seal coating. This will be a consideration if the budgeted funds permit. A “Revised” Mandatory Bid submittal form is attached. Additional concerns or reservations may be placed on the “Exceptions Page” if needed.**
