Join Naturalist Jerry Walls as he conducts professional guided birding & nature tours throughout the beautiful 17,500 acre preserve known as Hobcaw Barony. Dozens of species of birds, animals & wildflowers can be located throughout Hobcaw which is also rich in cultural history. Depending on the season, possible bird species include bald eagles, ospreys, painted buntings, endangered red-cockaded woodpeckers, shorebirds, wading birds & more. Tour includes scenic views of several ecosystems including fresh water wetlands, marsh & salt water tidal flats.

Tours will be held the **3rd Saturday of every month beginning May 15, 2010**. Registration will close the Mon. before each 3rd Sat of every month & you must pre-register. Meeting place will be the parking lot at Hobcaw Barony at 8:00am. Tour will end at Noon.

Transportation throughout Hobcaw will be provided by Parks & Recreation Dept. \$25.00 pp. Ages 14 & up. Please bring your own camera, binoculars, snacks, drinks and insect repellent (in warmer months).
