County receives report of person posing as employee

Georgetown County government recently received a report of a white male identifying himself as a county employee after being spotted in front of an area home shortly after the homeowners left the house. Several homes in that neighborhood had recently been broken into. The man said he was performing an inspection for the county. However, when asked to show identification, he refused, claiming he wasn't required to do so.

The public is advised that any Georgetown County employee performing job duties on private property will show an employee identification card if asked. The card is normally displayed on clothing when employees are in the field. Additionally, employees assigned to inspections, assessments and other duties in the field will normally be driving county-owned vehicles with the county's seal on the sides and government-issued license plates. These vehicles are usually white and will most likely be one of two models: Jeep Liberty or Ford Escape.
