This addendum will amend **Bid #09-017, CTC Rural Roads Improvement Program, FY09** originally issued on Friday, May 15, 2009. This clarification is being provided to all known and registered correspondents in response to an inquiry received for additional information. All addenda and original bid documents are also available online at: <http://www.georgetowncountysc.org>, select "purchasing" and then "current bids".

QUESTION: What spec would you like the Pav't Markings, and what kind would you like? 4" white on the edges of Pav't and 4" double yellow in the center?

ANSWER: Rather than specify a project price by segment, it will be easier for comparison if we modify the pavement marking prices as follows:

Pavement markings, if required to be furnished by the Contractor, will be paid for by the lineal foot applied. Use 4" thermoplastic yellow truck work 90 mil and 4" thermoplastic white truck 90 mil for pavement marking. Normally center line, edge of pavement lines and stop lines are required on all newly paved roads.

To accommodate this change, a REVISED Bid Submittal form will be attached that will include a single area for pavement marking items.

QUESTION: I see the length to complete this work is eight months but I can not find the liquidated damages. I assume they are \$500.00 per calendar day. Is this correct?

ANSWER: Yes, the item below is to be included in Section 3, Special Provisions:

3.08 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

The Contractor agrees to commence Work under this Contract on the effective date established as “Notice to Proceed”, and to complete the Work within eight (8) months of the NTP. Should the Contractor neglect, fail or refuse to complete the Work by any one of the key milestone activities by its critical interim completion date(s) or the established Completion date then the Contractor shall pay to the Owner Liquidated Damages in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for those damages suffered by the Owner as a result of delay for each and every calendar day that the Contractor has failed to complete any key milestone activity by its interim completion date or the established Completion date. The aforementioned Liquidated Damages are not a penalty, but rather are a pre-agreed liquidation of the losses incurred by the Owner due to failure of the Contractor to complete the Work on time.
