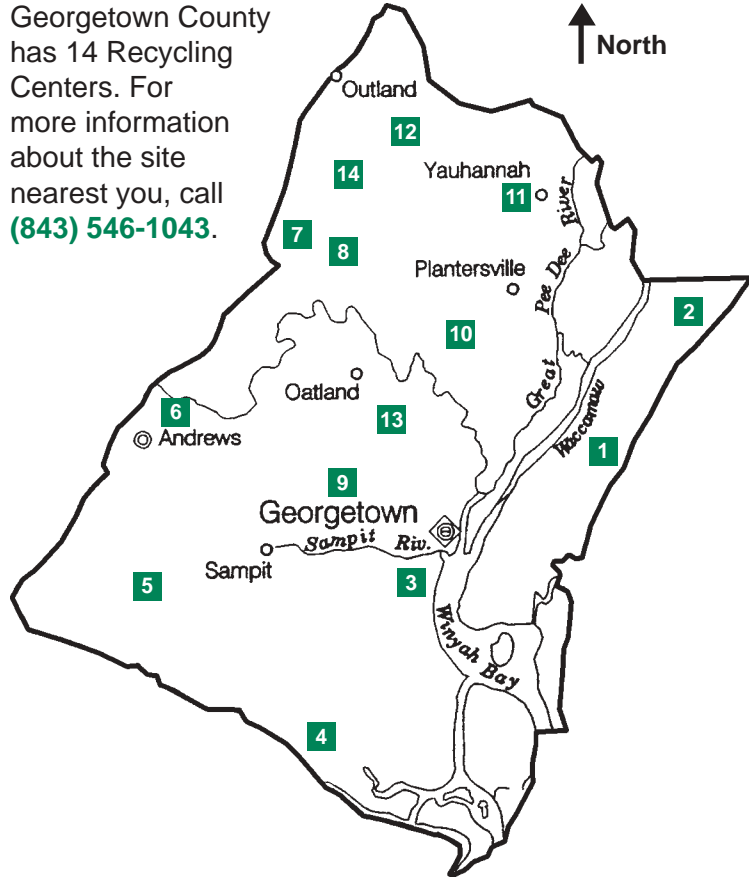


Georgetown County Recycling Center Sites

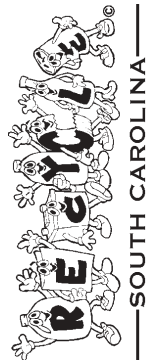

Why Recycle?

- **TO SAVE NATURAL RESOURCES**
 - For each ton of recycled glass used to make new glass, we save nine gallons of fuel.
 - Fifty-eight percent less water is used when paper is recycled instead of using raw materials.
- **TO SAVE ENERGY**
 - One aluminum can saves enough energy to run a television set for one hour.
 - Two gallons of used motor oil has enough energy to run the average household for 24 hours.
- **TO SAVE LANDFILL SPACE**
 - New landfills will cost taxpayers millions of dollars to provide a facility for the disposal of garbage.

Used Motor Oil Collection

Used motor oil, oil filters and empty motor oil bottles are frequently disposed of improperly. One gallon of used motor oil poured on the ground or in a sewer system can contaminate as much as 10,000 gallons of water...often the very water we drink.

To make proper disposal easy and convenient, containers for used motor oil, oil filters and oil bottles can be found throughout Georgetown County.

	WHAT TO RECYCLE:	HOW TO RECYCLE:	WHERE TO RECYCLE:
ALUMINUM	Aluminum beverage and scrap aluminum	Rinse beverage containers, cans and pans.	Recycling centers
APPLIANCES/SCRAP METAL	All appliances with metal parts (stoves, washers, dryers, refrigerators, grills, bicycles, etc.)		Recycling centers
BATTERIES, LEAD-ACID	Used automotive batteries		Recycling centers
CANS	Aluminum and steel	Completely empty paint cans.	Recycling centers
CARDBOARD	Corrugated cardboard (no wax finish) used for packing and shipping	Flatten.	Recycling centers
GLASS	Clear, green and brown (bottles and jars only)	Discard lids, rinse containers. Paper labels do not need to be removed.	Recycling centers
NEWSPAPERS	Dry newspapers; may include all newspaper inserts.	Do not tie or bag.	Recycling centers
OIL, FILTERS AND BOTTLES	Used motor oil, oil filters and oil bottles (oil must be free of gas or diesel fuel)	Remove lids and completely drain. Call DHEC's Recycling Office at 1-800-768-7348 for a FREE drain kit.	Recycling centers
PLASTIC	Soft drink and other narrow neck plastic bottles marked by a number 1 or 2 recycling symbol (usually found on the bottom), milk jugs. NO PLASTIC BAGS OR FILM.	Discard caps, rinse and flatten. Labels do not need to be removed.	Recycling centers
TIRES	Used automotive tires		Recycling centers
YARD WASTE	Brush from yards, limbs and clean construction wood		Recycling centers
